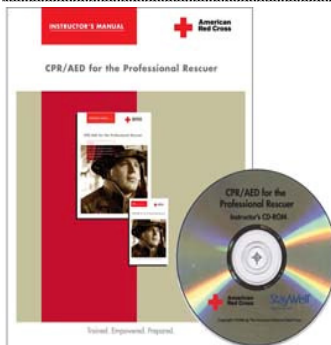
### Looking for First Aid Team Volunteers
