Program Release on March 31, 2011

The American Red Cross will be releasing the next generation of CPR, AED and First Aid programs on March 31, 2011. The new program can be taught immediately, but instructors must complete an instructor update prior to teaching. There will be several options for instructors to receive an update to teach the new program:
